What We Do

Summer Camp at St. Gabriel School is a wonderful, fun time for children in grades kindergarten through eight. Middle school students have the opportunity to be junior counselors in training. Under the watchful eyes of camp staff each child has fun! All summer camp sessions are staffed by trained teaching staff from St. Gabriel School. Staff is CPR certified.

- Camp is broken into four weekly sessions, each with their own theme.

Each weekly themed camp session will include craft projects, creation of daily culinary delights, games, water play and weekly field trips to area State Parks, bowling and/or movies, and local in-town venues.

What to Bring

St. Gabriel School Summer Camp will provide all of the materials needed for the daily activities. (art, snack making, water play...). Each camper needs to bring the following items:

- Snack, lunch and water bottle, no glass bottles or containers
- Change of clothes and sneakers
- Water shoes, bathing suit, and towel
- Bug spray and sunscreen
- Spending money for any field trips

Cost

The cost for each weekly session of St. Gabriel School Summer Camp is \$200.00 This fee does not include the admission prices for some field trips.

A Typical Day at Camp

- 9:00 am arrival and attendance
- Younger campers are paired up with a buddy for the week
- Campers and their buddies are divided into two smaller groups. Each group heads to crafts or snack making.
- Snack and outdoor playtime
- Groups switch activities (snack making or crafts)
- Lunch
- Outdoor play, water time, volleyball, playground...
- Snack (that they made earlier in the day)
- Play time
- Dismissal at 4:00 pm

Once a week campers take a field trip to a State Park for a day of swimming.

Once a week campers either go bowling, to see a newly released movie, or play a round of mini-golf.

Once a week campers walk to Bart's or other in-town venues.
