

General Admission Criteria

The following criteria/guidelines are used to determine acceptance into St. Gabriel School:

1. All Kindergarten applicants must undergo a screening to determine their social, psychological, and academic readiness for the all day Kindergarten program. Our current preschool students will be screened by the preschool teacher.
2. All students applying for Grades 1-7 must take an entrance test to determine grade level.
3. Latest academic records (report card) must be included with application
4. Parents must sign consent form to release academic, social and/or psychological records from current school.
5. Applicants for grades 1-7 will be invited to spend a day or part of a day at St. Gabriel School.

General Admission Policy

Acceptance is contingent upon the child's current academic transcripts (for grades 1 through 7), the results of readiness screening and the school's acceptance policy as indicated below:

1. Students who meet the academic criteria for admissions will be accepted based on the availability of openings and in the following priority:
 1. Families with children already attending St. Gabriel School
 2. St. Gabriel Parishioners
 3. Students from other Catholic Parishes
 4. Students whose parents/guardians are alumni of the school
 5. Students who are not affiliated with a Catholic Parish
2. The Principal reserves the right to require a conference with the applicant and family before a final decision is made.
3. The administration reserves the right to deny admission based on social and/or academic performance.
4. All new students for Grades K-7 are accepted on a one quarter probationary period. The administration reserves the right to request the withdrawal of the student from St. Gabriel School, if a student is unable to adapt to the education/social programs of the school at any time.

A letter of acceptance will be sent to each applicant's family after the admissions criteria are met. If any family questions the screening decision, a personal conference with the Principal may be requested.

Upon receipt of the acceptance letter, a deposit of \$150.00 must be submitted to the school in order to secure the student's placement. The deposit will be applied toward tuition.
