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WEEKLY ANGEL HIGHLIGHTS

Pre-K 3: We learned about endangered animals with our Guardian Angels, grade 5. We also saw a movie, colored pictures, and talked about our favorite ones. Some of these animals are in danger of becoming extinct if they and their homes are not protected.

Pre-K 4: PreK four had so much fun learning about Ocean animals and making different types of ocean animals. They also had fun sorting pictures that start with the letter Zz.

Kindergarten: Kindergarten students planted morning glory flowers and are watching them grow; learning the importance of the plant growth cycle.

Grade 1: First Grade had a show-and-tell where they worked on active listening.

Grade 2: Our grade two students participated with the eighth graders for the Crowning of Mary. We also are starting to learn all about our solar system! We also are just beginning to learn to multiply! WOW!

Grade 3: This week (and completing today- building their presentations) Grade three will complete the "Building My Own Zoo" Project... Spanning over: Literacy, Writing and Math..

Grade 4: Grade four learned about data sets and probability. We used bottle flips for our data and graphs.

Grade 5: We read an awesome article called "The Case of the Missing Bees," and Mr. T was blown away by how in-depth the conversations were. Almost every student had something impactful/meaningful to add to our conversation. The same thing happened with the verbal discussions when we finished "Brian's Return," also.

Grade 6: Students took a Test on Vocabulary Unit 15, the last set of words in their books. They began reviewing for their Vocabulary Final Exam, scheduled for Wednesday, May 29.

Grade 7: In Religion class, students studied the meaning of the "seven capital sins" by discussing ways to practice the virtues which are opposites to the sins.

Grade 8: Students continued to read George Orwell's 1984 and to write about the human rights which are being taken away from the book's characters.
