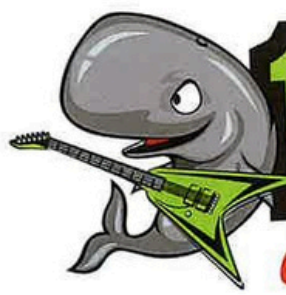

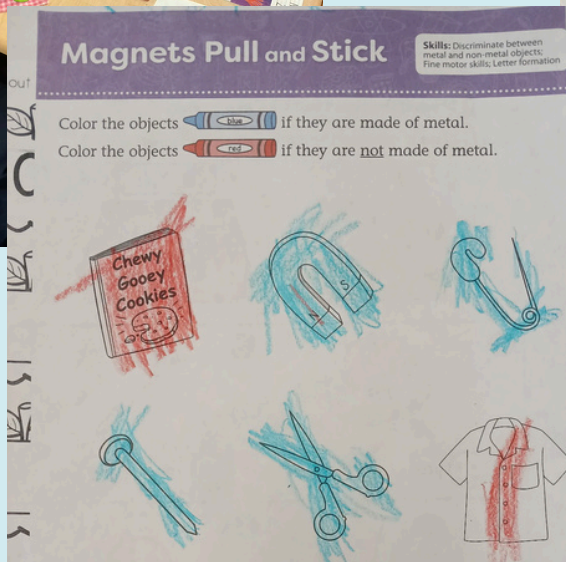
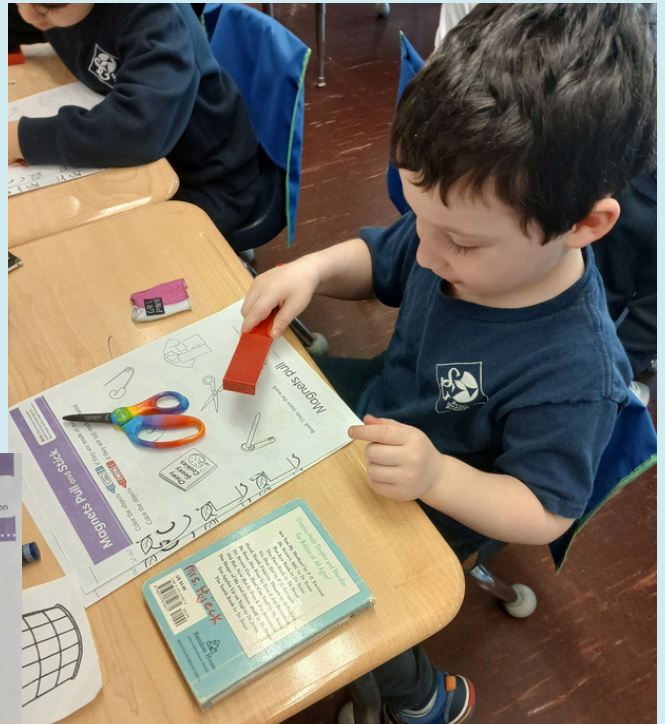

# Major SCHOOL CHOICE Legislation Reintroduced in Congress



Federal school choice legislation that passed out of a House committee last year has been reintroduced on Capitol Hill, **this time with genuine prospects for success.**

The Educational Choice for Children Act is based on tax credit scholarship programs that have had considerable success at the state level. Under the bill, private donors would contribute to scholarship granting organizations, which would use those privately donated funds to give scholarships to low and middle-income families for private school tuition. **The federal government would then give a tax credit to the donor.**
